SUBJECT: TWELFTH GRADE FLORIDA COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT TEST

(FCAT) RESULTS FOR 2003

Today, the Florida Department of Education released preliminary passing percents for grade twelve students who took the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) in March 2003. Of the 1,628 students who took the FCAT Reading subtest, 374 (23%) met or exceeded the passing criteria to earn a standard high school diploma. There were 1,355 twelfth grade students in Broward who took the FCAT Mathematics subtest, and of these, 528 (39%) students met or exceeded the passing criteria to earn a standard high school diploma.

Comparison to State and Other Large Districts in Florida

Table 1 presents the percentages of twelfth grade students in FCAT Reading and Mathematics for Broward, Florida, and four of the largest districts. Reading scores for Broward indicate a 23% passing rate, which is above Miami-Dade (22%) and Palm Beach (18%) but slightly below Orange (24%) and Hillsborough (28%).

In Mathematics, Broward 12th graders passed at a greater rate (39%) than Orange (38%) and Palm Beach (36%). Results for Broward are slightly lower than Hillsborough (42%) and directly in line with Miami-Dade (39%).
