SUBJECT: **THIRD GRADE RESULTS OF ALTERNATIVE ASSESSMENT FOR
PROMOTION**

Florida law requires that for students to be promoted to fourth grade, students must demonstrate readiness for fourth grade work by scoring Achievement level 2 or higher on the Florida Comprehensive Assessment (FCAT) Reading subtest, or by scoring at the 51st percentile or higher on the Norm Referenced (NRT) section of the FCAT Reading assessment. Students who did not score at or above these cut levels as identified by the Florida Department of Education, may demonstrate readiness by scoring at the 51st percentile or above on an alternative assessment or through a portfolio assessment strategy. The Florida Department of Education identified the Stanford Achievement Test-9th edition (SAT-9) as the alternative assessment.

In Broward County, third graders who were eligible to participate in the alternative assessment were administered the SAT-9 on May 20, 2003. **Of the 4,020 Broward County third grade students who participated in the alternative assessment, 11% (442) scored at the 51st percentile or above and are therefore eligible for promotion.** Students who have not yet met promotion requirements will be eligible to complete a portfolio assessment and may be eligible to attend the summer Reading program.
