SUBJECT: JUNE FCAT RETAKE SCORES

The Florida Department of Education (DOE) has released the results from the June 2002 Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) retakes for students enrolled in grades 11 and 12. The results for Broward are closely aligned with the percent passing rates for the state in both Reading and Mathematics.

The table below indicates the number of students tested at each grade level and the respective percent passing rate:

Students participating in the June assessment were students who had taken the FCAT at a previous time and had not received a passing score as well as students who may have been new to the state public school system. Twelfth grade students will have two additional opportunities to take the test prior to the June 2003 graduation dates. Students scheduled to graduate in June of 2004 will have five additional opportunities prior to graduation.
