**SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY RELEASE OF 2005 FLORIDA COMPREHENSIVE
ASSESSMENT TEST (FCAT) SUNSHINE STATE STANDARDS (SSS)
RESULTS, GRADE 3**

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) has released preliminary results from the 2005 Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) Sunshine State Standards (SSS) Reading and Mathematics subtests for third grade students in Broward County. These results are to be considered preliminary because reports providing state, district, and school-by-school summary data have yet to be released by DOE.

Grade 3 SSS Reading Preliminary Results

The preliminary results for Grade 3 FCAT SSS Reading demonstrate that Broward County students continue to make progress.

- **The percentage of third grade students in Broward County scoring at Achievement Level 3 or higher on the SSS Reading test has increased steadily over the past four years, from 62% in 2002 to 63% in 2003 to 65% in 2004 to 67% in 2005.**
- **The proportion of grade 3 students scoring at Achievement Level 1 in Reading continues to decline; this rate has decreased from 23% in 2002 to 20% in 2005.**
- **For schools where two years of data are available, 52% showed an increase in the percentage of grade 3 students scoring at Achievement Level 3 or higher in Reading. About 6% of schools maintained performance from last year.**
- **Preliminary results indicate that 80% of Broward third grade students are eligible for promotion to fourth grade based solely on their performance on the SSS Reading test.**

The preliminary results of the Grade 3 FCAT SSS have been made available for the purpose of identifying third grade students in terms of readiness for promotion to the fourth grade. According to Florida Statute 1008.25 (5) (b), third grade students are eligible for promotion by either scoring at Achievement Level 2 or above on the SSS Reading subtest or demonstrating an exemption from these criteria through good cause. One of the available good cause options for

demonstrating readiness for promotion to the fourth grade is achieving at or above the identified cut score on the Reading portion of the FCAT Norm Referenced Test (NRT). NRT results are not available at this time and, consequently, it is not yet possible to definitively identify students who are eligible or ineligible for promotion to the fourth grade.

Table 1 shows the results from the FCAT SSS Reading subtest for Broward's third grade students over the past four years. It can be seen that districtwide, there is a trend of increasing achievement in Reading. While fewer students scoring in Achievement Level 1 directly corresponds to higher proportions scoring at Achievement Levels 2 or above, there is still further growth demonstrated among the higher achievement levels (Level 3 or higher).

This trend can also be noted in the results presented in Table 2, which reports the districtwide estimates of third grade performance for 2005 compared to the previous three years on the FCAT SSS Reading subtest. Higher achievement is noted via a decrease in the number of students scoring at Achievement Level 1 and an increase in the number of students scoring at Achievement Levels 4 and 5.

These preliminary results lead to estimates that approximately 20% of Broward third graders are at risk for not meeting criteria for promotion to the fourth grade. However, those students may have demonstrated readiness for promotion on the Reading portion of the FCAT NRT, results of which are not currently available. For those students who did not demonstrate readiness for

promotion on either the SSS or NRT portion of the FCAT Reading test, there will be several opportunities for promotion through alternative methods:

- The Reading Comprehension subtest of the Stanford Achievement Test, Tenth Edition (SAT-10) will be administered on May 10, 2005, at the student's home school. Scoring at or above the identified cut score on the SAT-10 will satisfy requirements for promotion to the fourth grade.
- For those third grade students who still do not demonstrate readiness for promotion with the SAT-10, a Portfolio reading assessment will be conducted prior to the end of the 2004-05 school year.
- Students who do not meet the promotion criteria via the Portfolio assessment prior to the end of the 2004-05 school year will be eligible to attend Summer Reading Camp. Another Portfolio assessment will be administered at the conclusion of the Reading Camp.

Further information regarding promotion to the fourth grade will be provided as soon as it is available. Preliminary school-by-school results of Grade 3 SSS Reading are attached.

Grade 3 SSS Mathematics Preliminary Results

The preliminary results for Grade 3 Mathematics reflect significant gains among Broward's students relative to previous years:

- **74% of students scored at Achievement Level 3 or higher in Mathematics, an increase of 6% from the previous year.**
- **For schools where two years of data are available, 79% showed an increase in the number of students scoring at Achievement Level 3 or higher in Mathematics. About 3% of schools maintained performance from last year.**
- **The percentage of students scoring in Achievement Level 1 in Mathematics decreased from 15% in 2004 to 13% in 2005.**

Table 3 shows the results from the FCAT SSS Mathematics subtest for Broward's third grade students over the past four years. The percent of students who are performing at Achievement Level 3 or higher has increased by 8% since 2002, reflecting a significant gain of 6% from the previous year. Concordant with performance in SSS Reading, it can be seen that as the number of students in Achievement Level 1 decreases, there are corresponding increases in students scoring at higher levels.

Table 4 reports the district-wide estimates of third grade performance for 2005 compared to the previous three years on the FCAT SSS Mathematics subtest. It can be seen that in 2005 the percentage of students scoring at Achievement Levels 1, 2, and 3 decreased compared to the previous year and there is a corresponding increase in the number of students scoring at the highest levels of achievement (Levels 4 and 5). This suggests a continuing trend among third grade students of making gains in Mathematics beyond Achievement Level 3.
