SUBJECT: 2005 RESULTS OF GRADE 3 ALTERNATIVE ASSESSMENT FOR

PROMOTION

Florida Statute 1008.25 requires that third grade students demonstrate readiness for promotion to the fourth grade by scoring at Achievement Level 2 or higher on the Sunshine State Standards portion of the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT SSS) in Reading. Those students who do not earn scores at or above Achievement Level 2 on the FCAT SSS Reading test may be eligible for exemption from mandatory retention based on good cause. Among the available good cause exemption methods approved by the State Board of Education is earning a score at or above the 45th percentile in Reading on the FCAT Norm-Referenced Test (NRT) or the Stanford Achievement Test, Tenth Edition (SAT-10). Initially, 80% (approximately 16,831) of Broward third grade students scored at Achievement Level 2 or higher on the SSS Reading portion of the FCAT. Of the remaining grade 3 students that scored in Achievement Level 1 (approximately 4,208), less than one percent scored at or above the 45th percentile on the FCAT NRT in Reading.

In Broward County, third grade students who had not met the promotion criteria via the FCAT participated in the alternative assessment, the SAT-10 Reading Comprehension test, on May 10 and 11, 2005. As seen in the attached tables, of the 4,037 Broward County third grade students who participated in the alternative assessment, 11% (429) scored at or above the 45th percentile and are therefore eligible for promotion. Thus, to date, 83% of third grade students (approximately 17,390) districtwide have met the requirements for promotion to grade 4. Students who have not yet met promotion criteria will complete a portfolio assessment and may be eligible to attend the summer Reading program.
