Of the five largest districts in the state, composite and subtest mean scores were not remarkably different. The variation among the five districts' mean scores typically ranged within one point.

The lower mean scores at the district and state level compared to the national data are not unexpected. The national data reflect students who are most likely college bound and/or college ready. In Florida the ACT serves as a college entrance examination, as well as an alternative graduation examination for students *who have not met the FCAT graduation requirement*. As such, statewide and for Florida's districts, ACT mean scores include a broader range of students than the national picture.

Attached on the following page is a data table for the individual schools in Broward. Scoring notably high (2 or more points above the Broward average) were College Academy at BCC, Cooper City, Cypress Bay, Pompano Beach, and Marjory Stoneman Douglas. High schools scoring 2 or more points below the district average were Blanche Ely, Boyd Anderson, Coconut Creek, Hallandale, Miramar, and Plantation.
