**SUBJECT: RELEASE OF 2009 FLORIDA COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT TEST
(FCAT) RESULTS FOR GRADE 3**

Today, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released results from the 2009 Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test Sunshine State Standards (FCAT-SSS) Reading and Mathematics subtests for third grade students. This memorandum summarizes these results for the District. Specifically, the grade 3 Reading and Mathematics state, district, and school-by-school summary data for the FCAT-SSS are discussed. These scores are reported as the percent of students scoring in Achievement Levels 1-5. In general, the data reveal a steady long-term trend in academic progress at grade 3. It is important to note that while the District continues to undertake aggressive challenges and as the District becomes more urban, the District continues to show an upward trend in achievement.

A review of the assessment results indicates that:

- The percentage of third grade students in Broward County scoring at Achievement Level 3 or higher on the SSS Reading test decreased one percentage point in 2009, and remained stable on the SSS Mathematics test. Since 2005, the proportion of students scoring at or above Achievement Level 3 has increased from 67% to 71% on SSS Reading and from 74% to 80% on SSS Mathematics.
- The proportion of grade 3 students scoring at Achievement Level 1 in Reading increased by one percentage point (to 17%) in 2009. However, the proportion of Level 1 students has decreased by 3 percentage points since 2005.
- At least 84% of Broward third grade students are eligible for promotion to the fourth grade, based upon their performance on the SSS Reading subtest.

Grade 3 Reading and Mathematics Results

Table 1 shows the results from the FCAT-SSS for Broward third grade students over the past five years. The proportion of students performing at Achievement Level 2 or higher in Reading remained stable in 2009 (at 84%) compared to the previous year, and the proportion of students performing at Achievement Level 3 or higher in Reading decreased by one percentage point this year (from 72% to

71%). The percentage of third grade students performing within Achievement Level 1 registered a one percentage point increase from 2008 to 2009 (from 16% to 17%). The proportion of Broward third grade students eligible for promotion based upon their SSS Reading performance remained stable at 84%.

Table 2 shows the results from the FCAT-SSS Mathematics subtest for Broward's third grade students over the past five years. The percent of students who scored at Achievement Level 3 or higher has increased by six percentage points since 2005, and remained stable from 2008 to 2009 (at 80%). The proportion of Level 1 students has decreased by four percentage points from 2005 (from 13% to 9%).

Comparison to Statewide Results and Other Large Districts in Florida

The results released by FDOE today reflect that third grade students in Broward County continue to demonstrate steady long-term academic progress in Reading and Mathematics on the FCAT-SSS. In addition, these results indicate that Broward County students continue to perform in line with statewide averages and earn scores that exceed performance of students in other large districts throughout the state.

Table 3 presents the proportions of third grade students scoring in each Achievement Level in Reading for Broward, Florida, and four of the largest schools districts in the state (Miami-Dade, Hillsborough, Orange, and Palm Beach). The proportion of third grade students scoring at Achievement Level 3 or

higher in Reading in Broward County (71%) was equal to the statewide rate. However, Broward's student performance exceeded that of students in the other four large districts. Table 3 also shows that the proportion of third grade students in Broward scoring at Achievement Level 1 in Reading is similar to Florida, but lower than in the other four large districts.

Table 4 below presents the proportions of third grade students scoring in each Achievement Level in Mathematics for Broward, Florida, and the four other large districts. The proportion of third grade students scoring at Achievement Level 3 or higher in Mathematics in Broward County exceeded the state average and all four of the largest districts in Florida. Table 4 also shows that fewer third grade students in Broward scored at Achievement Level 1 in Mathematics than the state and three of the largest districts in Florida (and the same as Palm Beach).

School Level Results

A detailed list of performance by school is available on the Student Assessment Web site. An examination of the list revealed that the Reading proficiency rate at three schools exceeded 90%. These schools are Imagine Charter at Weston (96%), Charter School of Excellence (92%), and Virginia S. Young (92%). In addition, the Mathematics proficiency rate exceeded 95% at five schools: Imagine Charter at Weston (99%), Park Trails (97%), Somerset Academy Davie (96%), Gator Run (96%), and Pembroke Pines Charter (96%).

Promotion to Grade 4

The Grade 3 FCAT Reading test is used as a criterion for promotion into the fourth grade. According to Florida Statute 1008.25 (5) (b), third grade students are eligible for promotion by either scoring at Achievement Level 2 or above on the SSS Reading subtest or demonstrating an exemption through one of the Good Cause Criteria listed in Policy 6000.1. Today's data indicate that approximately 16% of Broward third graders (3,352 students) are at risk of being retained based on their performance on the SSS Reading test. However, some of these students will demonstrate readiness for promotion via Good Cause Criteria such as the Portfolio Reading Assessment conducted throughout the school year or the grade 3 SAT-10.

Next Steps

- **A list of grade 3 students who scored Level 1 will be posted to each school's DWH Reports folder on May 22. Using this list, schools are to identify students who are not eligible for Good Cause promotion (Policy 6000.1) and have not participated in SAT-10.**
- **Students who are not eligible for Good Cause promotion and who had not participated in the SAT-10 administered over the past two weeks must be assessed with SAT-10 prior to June 1.** You will assess these students using the SAT-10 available at your school and forward results to Student Assessment for scoring. If you need additional materials please contact Student Assessment at 754-321-4257.
- **The results from the SAT-10 administered over the past two weeks will be posted on the DWH by May 27, additional SAT-10 scores will be provided to schools as they are scored. Schools must recode, in TERMS, all of the students who are eligible for Good Cause promotion or who scored at or above the 45th percentile on SAT-10 to promoted.**
- Any student who does not meet one of the promotion requirements will be retained, but may enroll in the Grade 3 Summer Reading Camp and have an additional chance for promotion following the camp.
