SUBJECT: RELEASE OF 2010 FLORIDA COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT TEST

(FCAT) RESULTS FOR GRADE 3

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) has released results from the 2010 Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test–Sunshine State Standards (FCAT-SSS) Reading and Mathematics subtests for third grade students. This memorandum summarizes these results for the District. Specifically, the grade 3 Reading and Mathematics state, district, and school-by-school summary data for the FCAT-SSS are discussed. These scores are reported as the percent of students scoring in Achievement Levels 1-5. In general, the data reveal a stable long-term trend in academic progress at grade 3, particularly in Mathematics.

A review of the assessment results indicates that:

- The percentage of third grade students in Broward County scoring at Achievement Level 3 or higher on the SSS Reading test *increased* one percentage point in 2010, and remained stable on the SSS Mathematics test.
- Since 2007, the proportion of students scoring at or above Achievement Level 3 in Reading has *increased* from 68% to 72%. There was a Reading scoring anomaly at the state level in 2006, making that year inappropriate for baseline measurement.
- Since 2006, the proportion of students scoring at or above Achievement Level 3 in Mathematics has *increased* from 77% to 80%.
- The proportion of grade 3 students scoring at Achievement Level 1 in Reading *decreased* by one percentage point (to 16%) in 2010. The proportion of Level 1 students has *decreased* by 3 percentage points overall since 2007.
- At least 84% of Broward third grade students are eligible for promotion to the fourth grade, based solely upon their performance on the FCAT Reading subtest.

Grade 3 Reading and Mathematics Results

Table 1 shows the results from the FCAT-SSS for Broward's third grade students over the past five years. The proportion of students performing at Achievement Level 2 or higher in Reading remained stable in 2010 (at 84%) compared to the previous year, and the proportion of students performing at Achievement Level 3 or higher in Reading increased by one percentage point this year (from 71% to 72%). The percentage of third grade students performing within Achievement Level 1 registered a one percentage point decrease from 2009 to 2010 (from 17% to 16%). The proportion of Broward third grade students eligible for promotion based solely upon their FCAT-SSS Reading performance remained stable at 84%.

Table 2 shows the results from the FCAT-SSS Mathematics subtest for Broward's third grade students over the past five years. The percent of students who scored at Achievement Level 3 or higher has increased by three percentage points since 2006, and remained stable from 2008 to 2010 (at 80%). The proportion of Level 1 students has decreased by two percentage points from 2006 (from 10% to 8%).

Comparison to Statewide Results and Other Large Districts in Florida

The results released by FDOE indicate third grade students in Broward County continue to demonstrate steady long-term academic progress in Reading and Mathematics on the FCAT-SSS. In addition, these results indicate that Broward County students continue to perform in line with statewide averages and earn scores that exceed performance of students in other large districts throughout the state.

Table 3 presents the proportions of third grade students scoring in each Achievement Level in Reading for Florida, Broward, and four of the largest schools districts in the state (Miami-Dade, Hillsborough, Orange, and Palm Beach). The proportion of third grade students scoring at Achievement Level 3 or higher in Reading in Broward County (72%) was equal to the statewide rate. Broward's student proficiency rate exceeded that of students in the other four large districts. Table 3 also shows that the proportion of third grade students in Broward scoring at Achievement Level 1 in Reading is similar to Florida, and lower than the other four large districts.

Table 4 presents the proportions of third grade students scoring in each Achievement Level in Mathematics for Florida, Broward, and the four other large districts. The proportion of third grade students scoring at Achievement Level 3 or higher in Mathematics in Broward County exceeded the state average and all four of the largest districts in Florida. Proportionately, fewer third grade students in Broward scored at Achievement Level 1 in Mathematics than the state and three of the largest districts (and the same as Palm Beach).

School Level Results

A detailed report of performance by school is attached. Four schools demonstrated remarkable Reading proficiency rates, exceeding 95%: Bayview, Imagine Charter Weston, Kidz Choice Charter, and Somerset Academy Davie. In addition, the Mathematics proficiency rate exceeded 95% at six schools: City of Pembroke Pines Charter, Gator Run, Imagine Charter Weston, Kidz Choice Charter, Manatee Bay, and Park Trails.

Promotion to Grade 4

The Grade 3 FCAT Reading test is used as a criterion for promotion into the fourth grade. According to Florida Statute 1008.25 (5) (b), third grade students are eligible for promotion by either scoring at Achievement Level 2 or above on the SSS Reading subtest or demonstrating an exemption from this criterion through good cause. Today's data indicate that approximately 16% of Broward third graders are at risk of being retained based on their performance on the SSS Reading test. However, some of these students will demonstrate readiness for promotion via Good Cause Criteria including the Portfolio Reading Assessment conducted throughout the school year, performance on the SAT-10 Reading test, or the assessment following summer reading camp.
