MXP - PRESENTATION, SCREENS, LAYOUT INFORMATION

- 1. When you're **in DUO Video** mode and presenting to another party in the call and the other party launches their presentation, it will override the initial presentation being shown. When the second presenter is done and they go back to their main camera screen, the original presentation will show again.
- 2. <u>STOP PRESENTATION BUTTON</u> When you press this button while in the presentation mode, it will take you out of DUO Video mode. If you hit presentation again, it will ask you again if you want to open DUO video or not.

STOP Presentation Button looks similar to this.



- 3. When you are NOT in Duo Video mode and you hit the presentation button, the PC is acting as a sole input or stand-alone camera. You will be sending only **one image**, (that of the pc unit). The "STOP PRESENTATION" button will be grayed out at this time on the menu bar in this mode.
- 4. If you toggle to the "START PRESENTATION" button on the menu bar while NOT in Duo Video mode, you will be able to show a "Full Screen" layout on the local side/local monitor.

START Presentation button looks similar to this.



- 5. Once you go back to the **main camera** while NOT in DUO Video mode, it will take away the functionality of seeing a full screen of the presentation locally.
