results with committee and chair signed off on report. Summer camp has
changed and might not be a good fit for DBES due to our population.

Might be too expensive for our families to afford. \$125.00 before activity fees.

V. **Survey-Advanced Ed (eProve).....Mr. Gerlach**
Additional time provided to allow for more parents to complete survey. All parents in attendance had completed the survey. Also, any stakeholders were asked to complete a stakeholder survey about school advisory council regarding our School Improvement Plan

VI. **Title One Update.....Ms. Soeder**
Each item was reviewed by committee for the 2019-2020 school year. These are the recommendations from SAC.

Parent Compacts- Add limit screen time to our Parent Compact. New system name/Clever/SSO will replace Virtual Counselor/Beep as parent resource. Change dates to reflect next year. Also, change “state issued ID” to “government issued ID” for signing in purposes.

Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) – 2018-2019 Plan:

2019-2020 Plan: No additional changes with the exception of dates for new school year and possible the person in charge of different events. Motion to approve – all in favor to approved new plan.

School Improvement Plan- Ongoing and we will review at the next meeting- May 8th.

Parent Involvement Allocation- Funds for title 1 for parent communication/involvement. Agendas are funded through this funding which will continue for next year as well. If more funds available, then possible food/drinks for family curriculum events.

Annual Evaluation Survey- Paper survey results came back-overall, pleased with results as nothing came back with “a lot of red or disagree”.

The results are as follows:

61% felt teachers, principals, and other staff are willing to communicate with the parent

65% felt respected.

43% of parents indicated that they receive materials to help students do better in school.

67% help their child with homework/schoolwork

47% of the parents surveyed had knowledge of the information

that was used to determine whether their child moves to next grade or is retained.
44% of our parents receive information from the school to help their child succeed.
75%k of our parents know how to contact our teachers and feel welcome.
53% reported that if needed, translators were available and able to help during parent meetings and other school activities. When asked whether they requested specific activities, meeting or materials, from their child’s school, 31% of parents answered, “Strongly Agree” and 28% of parents answered “Agree”. 45% of our parents felt that the school responded quickly. An area to improve would be more documents translated and available in multiple languages for parents to understand better.
