General Meeting Minutes
November 13, 2018 – 8:00 am

Welcome/ Role Call to Establish Quorum:

Mr. Duverneau and Mr. Gibson welcomed all SAC committee members to the meeting.

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Duverneau read the minutes and they were approved by Ms. Mosely and second by Mr. Jean-Baptiste.

Highlighting Success:

Mr. Duverneau projected / highlighted some of Palmview's success through Dads Day, Student of the Month, follow Palmview on Twitter, Field Day for students who scored a level 3 or higher on the FSA (2017-2018) and the magnificent Harvest Day parade through Leisureville. In addition, Mr. Duverneau spoke about multiple instructional strategies implemented in classrooms school wide, various after school clubs and sports activities. In conclusion, Mr. Gibson highlighted how all these things contribute to overall Palmview success.

Development of 2018-2019 School Improvement Plan (SIP):

School Improvement Plan was reviewed by Mr. Duverneau. The plan provides mechanism for identifying needs and establishing a common approach to meeting those needs at the school level. Mr. Duverneau informed members about the process of meetings such as Professional Learning Communities (PLC) and RTI (Response to Intervention). On Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, teachers, coaches and administration meet to discuss students' progress, share best practices,

and analyze students' academic data. Mr. Duverneau spoke briefly on the School Wide Behavior Plan and a copy will be provided at the next SAC meeting. Lastly, Mr. Duverneau opened the floor for the committee to give input.

Principals Updates:

Mr. Gibson went over two (2) hand outs:

SMART Bond Program (Smart, Music, & Art, Athletics, Renovation and Technology):

November 2014, Broward County voters approved an \$800 million bond referendum that provides critically needed funding for students and schools. Broward County Public Schools has committed to investing the funding in safety, music, art, athletics, renovations, and technology (SMART) at every school.

The Office of Facilities and Construction is tasked with renovations to schools based on the SMART program needs assessment.

Improvements to school facilities include:

- Technology equipment
- Indoor air quality
- School safety systems
- Music and athletic equipment
- Renovations to more than 30 million square feet of school

***Improvements at Palmview as follows:**

- Grades 2 through 5 have their own assigned laptops.
- Smart boards and Recordex in every classroom.
- Two(2) full computer labs
- New roof, window, exterior walls painted.
- Fire sprinklers
- Single point entry to the school (Palmview)

***Upcoming improvements** here at Palmview are HVAC and Media Center. The Media Center is in the design phase and toward the end of the school

year renovation will start. Each student will receive a SMART flyer to take home.
