3. **School Improvement Plan (SIP) Updates by Principal and Departments**
 - Guidance- Eric Belliard - Absent – Registration process has begun for underclassmen.
 - Reading/Writing – Anita Parsotan – Very busy time of year for ELA. Preparing for writing and FSA’s. ELA camps will start on Feb 5th. Practice for FSA and SAT has begun as well. Both are being offered for the first time. Literacy Week is February 4th through the 8th. Students will be able to write a review of a novel they have read.
 - Math – Denise Miranda – Absent – Mr. Glatzer - The math department is offering tutoring through MAO on Wednesdays after-school in room 536. The department is using Khan Academy for EOC and SAT prep in all courses. Math teachers have started the push-in and pull-out program in the Algebra and Geometry classes.
