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1. **Call Meeting to Order** Mrs. Weaver calls the meeting to order at 3:05 pm. We do not have quorum
  
2. **School Improvement Plan (SIP) Updates by Principal and Departments**
  - Guidance- Eric Belliard - Absent – Registration process is still ongoing with the underclassmen.
  - Reading/Writing – Anita Parsotan – SAT and FSA camps have started, and we have had great attendance so far. Camps are Tuesdays/ Thursdays 2:45-4:00. English teachers are also working on their second writing sample so that they can provide feedback to their students for the April FSA writing test. We celebrated literacy two weeks ago and had many students present original writing in preparation for the literary fair. This year we have many entries and are looking to the rules.
  - Math – Denise Miranda – Absent – Mr. Renzo. The math department is offering tutoring through MAO on Wednesdays after-school in room 536. The department is using Khan Academy for EOC and SAT prep in all courses. All teachers have linked students PSAT scores to their Khan Academy accounts to utilize personalized test prep. Math teachers have started the push-in and pull-out program in the Algebra 1 and Geometry classes. For push-ins, teachers are going into other classes to help give one on one and small group instruction to students. For pull-outs, the teachers are pulling-out small groups during the student's study hall to give extra help. The push-ins and pull-outs are to help the students prepare for the upcoming EOC. In addition, Algebra 1 and Geometry teachers are volunteering to stay after school 3 days a week to help prepare students for the EOC coming up May 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - Science – Vamini Ramkissoon – Absent – Ms. Webb. Biology classes continue to collect data by comparing test scores (on standards) to the diagnostic test we administered in January. The teachers also continue to bring in literature by having students read and complete data nuggets and history articles on scientists. Tutoring for the EOC will start after spring break.
  - Principal Updates – Vivian Suarez –. Many sports are ongoing. Please support those students and events. The single point of entry has started. There are different murals painted around the school as part of the beautification process. Colt Café is canceled this month. The culinary students will be participating at states. Mrs. Suarez will be having her top 10% luncheon for senior students. The band received many medals recently and 24 students qualified for states.
