New Business:

1. Voting for co-chair of SAC

2. Language Enrichment Camp – Leslie Pickett
 1. State gives \$4,000 for after school tutoring to help ELL students to prepare for testing from Feb – April, Mon – Thurs. Non-ELL students are allowed to participate as well. Students will be made aware of tutoring opportunities.
3. Testing
 1. During study hall, there will be ELA enrichment to prepare students for testing.
 2. Feb 25 – Mar 15 are retakes for FSA ELA/Algebra only. Biology, Geometry and US History will NOT be available during this time, but will be available during the EOC in May.
 3. Feb 26, there will be no retakes, we will be giving the National Association for Education Progress (NAEP) exam. Seniors will be randomly selected to take the assessment and it is voluntary. Students will get service hours for taking this assessment.
 4. FSA ELA Writing 9th/10th is April 1st – April 5th . Testing will start on Tuesday or Wednesday. Writing is needed for the ELA test.
 5. Testing calendar for May has been sent to the District and is awaiting approval.
4. Differentiated Accountability (DA) Report

1. It's more critical this year that students show up for testing since the testing window is so short.
2. We received the Magnet School of Distinction designation.
3. There's a college fair on 2/13 from 8:00 – 10:00.
4. On 4/30, BSO will do a MADD presentation for seniors and Juniors

Lunch will be inside as well. Parents can sign students out as needed. New cameras have been installed on campus so there are no dead areas that aren't visible.
