Grade Level Reports

Kindergarten – Our homework initiative is in the 2nd year and seems to be well

received by parents. We will have our ABC Bootcamp letter parade on

Wednesday. Our Storybook parade on October 31.

1st grade – First is doing a pumpkin unit – they will be growing their own pumpkins.

They are also working intently on curriculum including High Frequency words.

2nd grade – Second is working on geography, number sense and meeting reading standards.

3rd grade – Third is having so much fun with Yoga on Thursdays. They are learning relaxing skills that will be useful when testing time comes around.

4th grade – Fourth is concentrating on reading curriculum, I ready and math

5th grade – Fifth did their Rocket Rally – an in-house STEM field trip. It was great. They are also participating in the SEEDS program – showing growing food for healthy living.

Specials – The specials team is working with grade levels to integrate core curriculum into their lessons. Dr. Prochaska and Dr. Cady are doing the Robotics Club to prepare students for the VEX competition in February. Ms. Moore shared her Open Media times. They will also be hosting the annual “Monster Mash” on our early release day.
