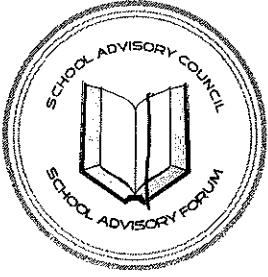

**School Advisory Council**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
**May 21, 2018**

Call meeting to order by Diane Jordan, SAC Secretary, in Mrs. Bevins absence.

**Roll call** was taken by Diane Jordan at 9:05 AM. 9 SAC members answered present. We do not have a quorum.

**Approval of Meeting Minutes:** Mrs. Ward made a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Duhart seconded the motion. A vote was taken. The motion to approve the April minutes was approved.

**SIP – Monitoring of our SIP:** Mr. Duhart shared information about procedures. Information was shared about SAC procedures. The SAC Secretary will obtain the template for meeting minutes to use in the future.

Mrs. Seltzer shared information from the District North Area Advisory Council: Parent/Customer Survey: The district will not be using the same survey from Advanced Ed. Next year, there will be a new format. The questions will be more specific to the school. Elections were held; a new chair will serve in the fall. The boundary process has been modified. An I Zone rep will be selected at the beginning of next school year. Early Intervention/Head Start policies will be modified to align to the standards. The Broward School District has their own police department. The Chief of Broward School Board Police Department will be asked to speak to group. Curriculum is changing. New Social Studies materials were rolled out this year. New Science materials will be rolled out in the fall. Representatives from the different curriculum areas will be asked to speak to the group.

**Principal's SAC Report:** Mrs. Seltzer shared that the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade FSA scores hopefully will be coming soon, no later than May 31st. The 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> scores are usually released on the planning day after the last day of school. Rainy day procedures are being refined. Administration extends heartfelt appreciation for your patience. Lightening safety is first and foremost. Rainy Day Procedures will go home in the first day packet. PreK classes will visit the media center next school year.

**Updates for next year:** The district has received a Serve Grant. Each school in the Stoneman Douglas Zone will receive an additional guidance counselor for next school year and beyond. Resources are available for request if students or staff are in need of counseling.

Parking suggestions were shared. A school-counseling program was suggested that the counselor would go into each class to teach coping skills and other strategies. Mrs. Seltzer shared that the school is looking into several program for next year. Riding the Waves, stress management for 5<sup>th</sup> grade and The Sandy Hook Project, grades PreK-5, touches on kindness, bullying, dealing with emotions are two of the possibilities.
