Administration has been having data chats with students bringing out their leadership binder, reviewing the data, and setting goals using the Leader in me vocabulary. Also using i-ready, it was noticed that many of the student in the bottom quartile have few minutes in i-ready. Steps were discussed with these students on how increasing their minutes in i-ready can help to improve. The goal is to hopefully get these data chats done with students thru 3rd grade.
